FIRE PIT USE REGULATIONS

- 1. The fire pit is available for use to all unit owners of the association. Guests are always welcome but must be in the presence of a current unit owner.
- 2. Never leave a fire unattended.
- 3. Someone over the age of 18 years old must be present at all times when the fire pit is in use.
- 4. Fire starter sticks or recyclable cardboard are permitted for use when starting a fire. The use of liquid accelerants is strictly prohibited.
- 5. The burning of trash/landscape/yard waste is also prohibited.
- 6. Dry firewood is the only material approved when fueling a fire.
- 7. Please ensure that you have a bucket of water, fire extinguisher, or garden hose readily available at all times when the fire pit is in use.
- 8. All fires must be thoroughly extinguished, and embers completely cooled before leaving the fire pit unattended.
- 9. Fires cannot exceed 2 feet in height, and 3 feet in diameter.
- 10. There currently aren't any restrictions in regards to hours of operation per the Village of Rockton, and the fire pit is available for year-round recreational use.
- 11. Please be respectful of your neighbors during use.
- 12. The fire pit is not intended for the cooking/preparation of food. However, S'mores are always allowed!
- 13. Please make sure that you clean up after yourself, and that you dispose of any garbage appropriately.
